




INFORMATICS joint efforts lead to Policy Recommendations

- responsible informatics research and technology development is encouraged, centred on human interests and building on/respecting its diversity;
- the transparency and accessibility of informatics research, incl. for instance an appropriate way to evaluate informatics researchers.
