About this year's Award

• A total of 12 nominations from 8 different countries were received, with initiatives focused on any stage of the career pipeline of women in informatics research and education;

Evaluation process:

- Each nomination was evaluated by at least three reviewers.
- A panel discussed top-ranked submissions and selected the best 3 for re-evaluation.
- A 9-dimensions evaluation was used by the committee to grade the top-ranked submissions to reach a unanimous decision.
- The scores were summed to identify the highest-ranked proposal across all dimensions.

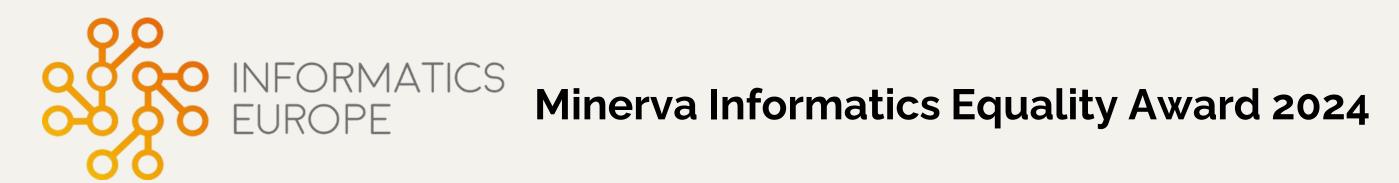
